

CDNIS and IB by the Numbers

CDNIS is **1** of only six through-train IB schools in Hong Kong, and one of 150 worldwide.

Money set aside in the CDNIS annual budget for staff training and professional development.

\$ 2 . 2 million dollars

EVERY year **EVERY** teacher has the option to attend one local and one overseas training opportunity.

99.4% of CDNIS teachers are IB trained

IB requires that only one teacher per grade or one teacher per subject be IB trained.

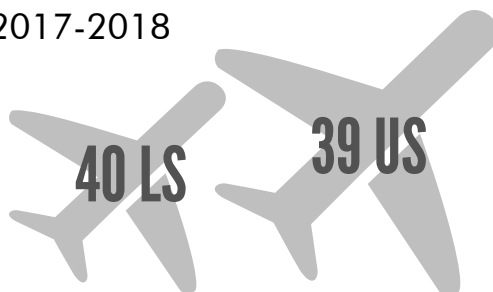

CDNIS has a comprehensive roadmap for all teachers to achieve the required IB training and more.

40

CDNIS students scored 40 points of higher for their IB diploma in 2017-18.

36.9 was the average CDNIS IB score. The worldwide average was 30.

One CDNIS student scored a perfect **45** 11 CDNIS students scored **43 or 44**

93% of CDNIS students scored above the worldwide average.

46% of Class of 2018 joined CDNIS in Grade 1 or earlier.
