

IB and CDNIS by the Numbers

CDNIS is **1** of only five through-train IB schools in Hong Kong, and one of 150 worldwide.

Money set aside in the CDNIS annual budget for staff training and professional development.

\$ 2 . 2 million dollars

EVERY year **EVERY** teacher has the option to attend one local and one overseas training opportunity.

92% of CDNIS teachers are IB trained

8% of CDNIS teachers are scheduled for IB training

IB requires that only one teacher per grade or one teacher per subject be IB trained.

11% of CDNIS teachers are certified as IB Leaders
