

CDNIS and IB by the Numbers

CDNIS is **1** of only eight through-train IB schools in Hong Kong, and one of 150 worldwide.

Money set aside in the CDNIS annual budget for staff training and professional development.

\$ 2 . 2 million dollars

EVERY year EVERY teacher has the option to attend one local and one overseas* training opportunity.
(*Due to current Covid-19 restrictions, these sessions are currently being conducted online.)

100% of CDNIS' teaching faculty are IB trained

IB requires that only one teacher per grade or one teacher per subject be IB trained.

13% of CDNIS teachers are certified as IB Leaders

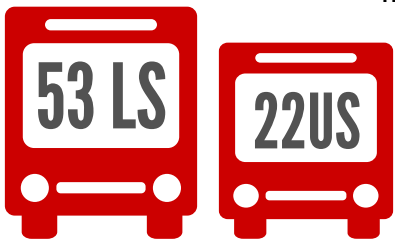

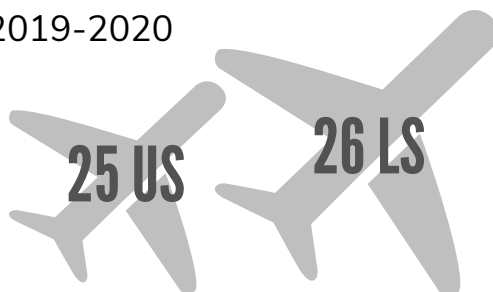

CDNIS has a comprehensive roadmap for all teachers to achieve the required IB training and more.

54

CDNIS students scored 40 points or higher for their IB Diploma in 2021.

40 was the average CDNIS IB score. The worldwide average was 33.

Six CDNIS students scored a perfect **45** 19 CDNIS students scored **43/44**

98% of CDNIS students scored above the worldwide average.

38% of the Class of 2021 joined CDNIS in Grade 1 or earlier.
