Most of you will know that Chief Executive Carrie Lam conducted a press conference yesterday afternoon. A number of social distancing restrictions will be put in place in Hong Kong in the ongoing effort to control the Omicron variant outbreak, effective at midnight today.

Fortunately, schools are able to remain open, at least until the government's next review of the situation in 7 days' time. However, there are now limitations on [large gatherings and non-essential activities](#) which have led us to cancel or postpone events involving visitors and volunteers to campus, as well as off-site activities such as sports competitions involving students from other schools.

Effective tomorrow, we will close the fitness room and swimming pool to students and staff. An extra thorough cleaning and fumigation of the whole campus will take place over the weekend. Apart from that, please be assured that we will take measures to conform to the latest health and safety regulations with as few disruptions as possible to student routine. We will continue our daily deep cleaning of the campus, our regular application of Germagic MAP-1 Smart Coating, and to enforce our temperature-taking, mask-wearing and hand-sanitizing protocols with our usual vigilance.

Finally, I urge everyone eligible to take the second or third COVID-19 vaccine to do so as soon as you are able, as we are expecting new instructions from EDB concerning acceptable vaccination levels before the end of the month.

As always, thank you for your understanding and collaboration. This is not the New Year's message I had imagined sending at the start of 2022, but working together as a community we will weather this latest storm and emerge as strong as ever!
