We have kept a close watch on the COVID-19 situation and its potential impact on our community this week and are pleased to confirm that school will re-open for face-to-face classes beginning **Monday, March 22**, using the same scale and [schedule](#) of the hybrid model that has been in place since February. Please remember to complete and submit the Student Health and Travel Declaration or your child will not be permitted entry.

We are pleased to share that no staff member or student has reported a positive test for COVID-19. One staff member and three students remain in quarantine having been classified as close contacts outside of the school, but all fortunately continue to bring back negative test results. CDNIS families who live in buildings where mandatory testing has taken place during the past few days have likewise reported negative test results.

This week our campus facilities team has been working hard to deep clean, fumigate and sanitize our classrooms and common areas. We are looking forward to welcoming back our students and remain grateful to those of you who have candidly reported your family's health situation.
