



Dear CDNIS Community,

In light of the recent announcement by the Department of Health that students between the ages of 12-17 need only receive one vaccination to be considered fully vaccinated, I am happy to share the good news that our eligible student body is 72% fully vaccinated as of today. That statistic, along with the fact that 97% of our staff are fully vaccinated, will enable us to continue to run [full face-to-face classes](#) as well as provide a full range of After School Activities (ASAs) after the October break. When your child turns 12, please reserve a vaccination appointment as soon as possible so that we may maintain the baseline mandate of a minimum of 70% fully vaccinated and be able to remain fully open.

Next week, you will receive details from our ASA and Aquatics teams about course options and how to enrol. We are working closely with our bus transportation providers, KCM, to offer extended bus service to students participating in ASA, Athletics and Aquatics programmes after school. At this point, we have no plans to change the staggered start times for Lower and Upper School and will continue to insist that no private cars except those carrying EY students access Nam Long Shan Road during school hours.

We truly appreciate your collaboration and participation in keeping our students safe and are very excited about the near return to normalcy at school. We wish you a restful weekend and a wonderful Mid-Autumn celebration next week!
