As I am sure you are aware, this afternoon, the Secretary of Education, Kevin Yeung, held a press conference where he confirmed that schools, including international schools, may resume face-to-face classes later in September. You will find the dates in [this letter](#) sent concurrently with the press conference by EDB.

As I shared with you last Friday, the school has already submitted a detailed proposal to the EDB for the resumption of face-to-face classes and we are currently in dialogue with our Regional Education Officer (REO) regarding its modification. These modifications may include changes to the October and/or Christmas breaks in order to maximize face-to-face learning as well as provide an opportunity for families to travel and observe the current quarantine requirements. We will keep you apprised of the progress of our discussions and negotiations.

We thank you in advance for your patience, support and understanding during this time and we are excited to welcome your children back on campus later in a few weeks of learning, and will certainly keep you apprised as soon as we know more.
