



**CDNIS Students Achieve Perfect Score
in 2022 IB Diploma Examinations**

Graduates of the Canadian International School of Hong Kong are celebrating after receiving their results for the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP). With one of the largest DP cohorts in Hong Kong at 96 students, CDNIS is thrilled that the students' perseverance, diligence and hard work resulted in the Class of 2022 achieving an overall average of 39. Not only are our results significantly higher than the 2021 world average of 33 points, they place CDNIS once again among the top international schools in the world.

- Four students gained the maximum 45 for the IB Diploma
- Six students scored 44 points out of the maximum of 45 points
- The average diploma score was 39
- 51 students scored 40 points or higher
- Six students received the Bilingual Diploma
- The pass rate for the Diploma was 99%

Four notable individual achievements are Joanne To, Kiara Daryanani, Donald Chan, and Aaron Chin, who each achieved the maximum score of 45. Achieving a score of 7 in all six major subjects in addition to securing an A grade in both the Extended Essay and Theory of Knowledge is extremely difficult, making the award of 45 a truly exceptional achievement.

Upon receiving the news that she had achieved a perfect score, Joanne To, who has studied at CDNIS for 15 years said, "I am extremely excited and thankful to my family, teachers and peers who have supported me throughout this process."

Kiara Daryanani, who also attended CDNIS since she was 3 years old said, "I'm very, very happy to see that my hard work has paid off."

Class of 2022 Valedictorian Donald Chan said, "I felt like I was on top of a mountain. It truly warmed my heart celebrating with the ones I love most."

Aaron Chin said, "Stay resilient and always find intrinsic motivation in what you do!"

Head of School Dr. Jane Camblin said, "We are extremely proud of the resilience members of the Class of 2022 have shown over the past two years of their IB DP journey. Despite the challenges faced, they have shown strength, perseverance and fortitude to excel in one of the most rigorous academic programmes in the world."

Along with the IB Diploma, CDNIS students also graduate with the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD), making them amongst very few students globally to graduate with two distinct secondary school diplomas.

Members of the Class of 2022 have accepted offers to study at universities around the world including Cambridge, Oxford, University College London, Imperial College London, University of Pennsylvania, Cornell University, University of Toronto, The University of British Columbia, and The University of Hong Kong and have been offered more than HK\$16million in scholarships to study at these institutions.
