

CDNIS and IB by the Numbers

CDNIS is **1** of only six through-train IB schools in Hong Kong, and one of 150 worldwide.

Money set aside in the CDNIS annual budget for staff training and professional development.

\$ 2 . 4 million dollars

EVERY year EVERY teacher has the option to attend one local and one overseas training opportunity.

100% of CDNIS' teaching faculty are IB trained

IB requires that only one teacher per grade or one teacher per subject be IB trained.

27

CDNIS students scored 40 points or higher for their IB diploma in 2019.

36.5 was the average CDNIS IB score. The worldwide average was 29.6.

Three CDNIS students scored a perfect **45** Seven CDNIS students scored **43 or 44**

95% of CDNIS students scored above the worldwide average.

50% of the Class of 2019 joined CDNIS in Grade 1 or earlier.
